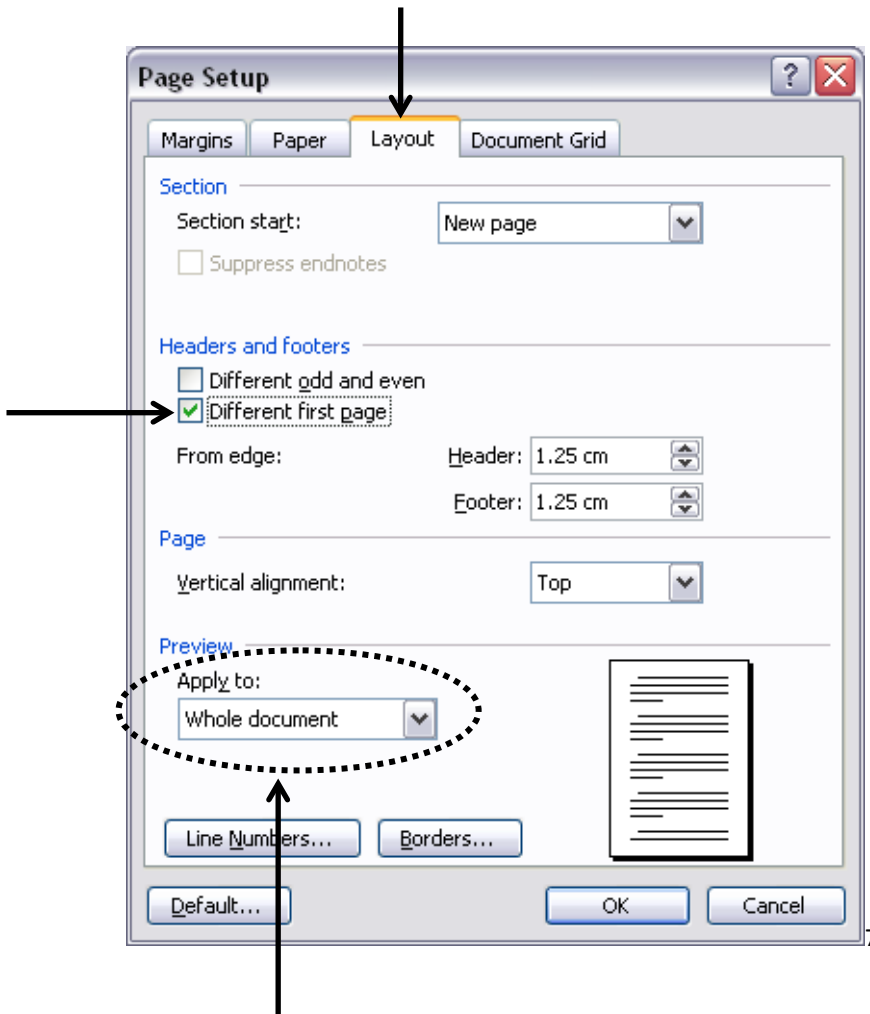


Page numbers different on the first page

Microsoft Word 2003

Different first page makes the first page of Header and Footer empty. This tip can be used for no page number on the first page.

1. **File > Page Setup**
2. Tick **Different first page** under **Headers and footers** in the **Layout** tab > Click **OK**



When you have no section in your document, probably apply **Whole document**.

However, when you have more than one section in the document, you may wish to apply **This Section** only. Otherwise, other section may also have no header and footer.



NB:

Different First Page does NOT allow for different page margins. Only inserting a section break allows you to have multiple margins.
