

Dragging and dropping cells

Microsoft Excel 2007

This is a quicker way to move a group of cells, rather than cutting and pasting cells to the new location within the same spreadsheet.

1. Highlight the cells to be moved

2. Mouse over on the outer borders of the selected block. The mouse cursor should change to a 4-way arrow (↕).
